Respect for others

- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all.
- I will treat everyone equally regardless of sex, ethnic origin, religion or ability.
- I will be a positive role model.
- I will respect the property of all venues associated with events.

Ensure a positive experience

- I will ensure that NYLETR events are a positive experience for all.
- I will be fair, considerate and honest with anyone, and communicate with simple, clear and respectful language.

Act professionally and take responsibility for my actions

- My language, manner, punctuality, preparation and presentation will demonstrate high standards during NYLETR events.
- I will display control, respect, dignity and professionalism to all involved in NYLETR events.
- I will encourage all Members/Volunteers to demonstrate the same qualities as above.
- I will refrain from any form of personal abuse towards anyone, including inappropriate or unwanted sexual advances on others, verbal, written, physical and emotional abuse.
- I will be alert to any form of abuse from other sources directed toward anyone affiliated with a NYLETR event.
- I will report any emergencies to the appropriate authorities after first taking immediate action to ensure the health and safety of the participants.
- I will refrain from an overindulgence of alcohol while representing LETR/SO

Quality service to the Athletes

- I will aspire to provide the highest quality event possible.
- I will be a positive role model for the athletes in the program.

Health and safety of the Athletes Present at NYLETR Events

- I will assist in ensuring that the equipment and facilities are safe to use.
- I will encourage Athletes to seek medical advice when required.
