Special Olympics New York provides year-round sports training and competition in over 22 Olympic-style sports for more than 68,000 children and adults with intellectual disabilities living in New York, giving them continuing opportunities. The cost incurred by Special Olympics NY to prepare and send the athletes to local competitions is \$400 per Athlete. Special Olympics Athletes or their families are NEVER charged to participate in Special Olympics programs. Our purpose is to allow Special Olympics New York athletes to showcase their talents and abilities, while improving self-esteem, developing social interactions and enhancing leadership skills on and off the playing field.
