Check-In: Check in at the volunteer registration table under the tent.

If you pre-registered online, give your name and show your ID to be checked in. If you have not been able to pre-register, be prepared to fill out volunteer paperwork and show your ID.

Please make sure to get a Special Olympics NY credential and write your name on it. This is used to identify each of the volunteers.

Training: After you are all checked in and have your credential, training is on-site.

Description—experienced: Enjoy some time with the athletes and the beloved horses they ride. Experience with horses will determine job placement. Volunteers with riding experience will fill jobs such as prepping, leading, and side walking horses. Volunteers without experience may assist with signage, registration, ring escorts, lunch, awards, and venue needs.

Description—non-experienced: Enjoy some time with amazing athletes and horses. Experience with horses will determine job placement. Volunteers without experience may assist with signage, registration, ring escorts, lunch, awards, and venue needs.

Qualifications: Ability to perform assigned duties for the duration of the competition, be flexible with assignments and able to be on your feet for stretches of time. Additional training will be available for horse-related volunteer tasks.

Lunch is not provided- please bring a bag lunch with you or lunch will be available for purchase from venue concession stands.
